

MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



The pandemic interrupted STS Academy's normal services to the community as well as the schools we serve. But we continued to support youth by working with schools to provide learning assistance in an online format, We provided tutoring for middle school and high school students during Covid. And our Learning Center was a host for children without stable homes or internet to access their classes online. We provided three locations for 1-6 grade children to come to every day to tune into their school classes. We helped them with homework, and provided enrichment activities

after school. The Contra Costa County Office of Education provided the resources for these learning hubs. We were pleased with the high level of academic success our children achieved with a stable place to learn, nutritious meals, and caring assistance from staff at The Learning Center.

ASSETS GRANT @ PITTSBURG HIGH SCHOOL

STS Academy provides before and after school academic services, enrichment classes, and career/job pathway classes to Pittsburg High School and Black Diamond High School through a 21st Century State administered ASSETs grants in cooperation with the Pittsburg Unified School District.

During the Covid years we provided online academic support services for students, and hosted a learning hub at Pittsburg High School so students could attend their online classes from that location. We also were able to offer some online enrichment, fitness and other after school classes.

STS Academy works in partnership with other organizations to provide opportunities for high school students through school clubs. One great example of a successful community-STS Academy-School Club venture is what we call Key Jeopardy. The Pittsburg Kiwanis Club, the Pittsburg High School Key Club, and community organizations as well as other high school clubs created and participated in an online jeopardy game. This has been held each spring for several years, operates like jeopardy does on TV with students providing hosting, questions, and technical assistance. It's a widely successful community project that is fun, and supports numerous community and school organizations.

As schools began to open in spring 2021, STS Academy expanded its career development and enrichment classes with topics like How to Start a Business, and a career pathway class in Construction, attended by students from Black Diamond and Pittsburg High School.



Pittsburg Kiwanis, STS Academy and Pittsburg High's Key Club have come together to provide a community fundraiser to benefit Pittsburg's Youth.

Community Groups of adults and Community Youth Groups challenged each other in Jeopardy games. Winners of each game earn \$100 and the high scoring teams would enter Final Jeopardy held later. Each team will need 3 participants.

Introduction to the Learning Center

STS Academy operates the Learning Center at 60 Civic Drive in Pittsburg. We provide before and after school care, academic support, and transportation service to elementary children K-6th grade. Working parents can drop their child off at 6am and pick the child up at 6pm. When needed STS Academy transports children to school from the Center and returns them to the Center after school, relieving the transportation burden often placed on working parents or guardians. This fee-based program is designed for families with various levels of income. Children enjoy enrichment, crafts, computer, outdoor and other activities. And after school, we focus children on their homework and help to insure they complete it. If needed, we will communicate with teachers to get clarification. During Covid our regular program was not available since school was not in session, and we transitioned to learning hubs for children who needed a safe and consistent location to access their online classes. That resulted in highly successful learning outcomes for those children.

In 2021 TLC upgraded all of its accounting and parent engagement software to a state of the art system that keeps parents in touch and involved 24/7. Transportation is provided to and from all schools in the Pittsburg Unified School District.


