

Tutoring & Homework Assistance

Daily tutoring and homework assistance available from credentialed teachers and trained student tutors

Football/ Baseball Study Hall

Help our players stay on track academically. This year no students were lost due to academic ineligibility

Conditioning for All

Exercise and straight building programs are available to our entire student body

College Prep

The staff in this program help prepare our students for college (college application, student financial assistance, college visits and more.

Drivers' ED

Required California Department of Motor Vehicles Classes to obtain a California Driver License - Taught by approved instructor with approved material.

Mastery Center

Much more than a study hall, a place for students to review and receive additional instructions on topics previously taught in their classes.

Folklorico

An Award Winning dance group who are funded by STS. This program recruits and trains new members as part of STS after school program

Improve your Tomorrow

Mentoring service for up to 150 Students.

Bridge Builders

Bridge Builders and STS Academy work with the PHS COST/CARE Team who administer and monitor the services needed for students with EWI (Early Warning Indicators). Combining resources on and off the school campus to provide quality services needed throughout the community, school system and campus.

Nutrition

Meals served before, noon and after school in collaboration with PUSD and the Federal Food & Drug Administration.

Barista

Students learn to preform Barista services and prepare coffee, latte and other coffee drinks for students in the program, other who visit and community events.

Teen 2 Teach

Trained high school students receive community service hours and a stipend to tutor students TK through 12th grade.

Mentoring

Youth receive life skill instructions, take field trips and attend a monthly breakfast with their entire family.

Gaming & Robots

Student challenge themselves and other students while improving their skills.
